## Reciprocal commitments between ProsperA and its members

ProsperA will provide its members with:

- a place for sharing and systematising experiences of using the SPI tool and of conducting governance analysis and impact analyses
- direct support in using the SPI tool and the governance analysis tool
- a guarantee by ProsperA and CERISE of the quality of the process for using the SPI tool and the governance analysis tool
- a space for reflection on the role of social performance and the factors necessary to improve practice (such as SP monitoring and evaluation, "good governance" and impact assessment) to strengthen the social impact of MFIs
- a space for international dialogue and representing the position of MFIs and their networks in order to promote the concept of social performance
- continually updated training and capacity building tools that are free to access and available in French, English and Spanish
- information on national and regional discussions and workshops organised by ProsperA members

In order to support collective action, ProsperA members commit to:

- using the SPI tool and governance analysis tool in accordance with the instructions set out in the Standards of Use of SPI
- involving CERISE in the process of using the SPI tool in order to jointly assess its quality
- give feedback to CERISE on the SPI tool so that it can be improved
- provide the results from MFIs that have used the SPI questionnaire in order to extend the SPI database (anonymously)
- publish with ProsperA, or communicate to its members, the non-confidential results of their analytical and research activities
- make systematic reference to the collective work of Cerise and ProsperA when using tools or training and capacity building materials, in particular by visible use of the logos
- inform CERISE systematically of any workshops, meetings and reports, etc. produced in ProsperA's areas of activity (such as subject, people present, objective of meetings, expected outcomes, dates and so on)
